This act made it legal to teach Native American children in indigenous languages and gave tribes the authority to control schools for Native American children. This was reinforced in the 1990’s when the US government passed the Native American Languages Act, which recognized the importance of preserving indigenous languages.

There were over 200 North American tribes speaking over 200 different languages. The United States used the uniqueness of the Navajo language to its advantage in World War II. Rather than encrypting radio messages, it proved simpler to use Navajos to speak to each other in their everyday language to convey high-security messages.

There is evidence suggestive that speakers of the Chumashan languages and Yukian languages, and possibly languages of southern Baja California such as Waikuri, were in California prior to the arrival of Penutian languages from the north and Uto-Aztecan from the east, perhaps predating even the Hokan languages.

The Cheyenne (/ˈtʃeɪˈnɪː ʃaɪ-ˈni/) are one of the indigenous people of the Great Plains whose language is of the Algonquian language family.The Cheyenne comprise two Native American tribes, the Só'taeo'o or Só'taétaneo'o (more commonly spelled as Suhtai or Sutaio) and the Tsétséhéstâhese (also spelled Tsitsistas).These tribes merged in the early 19th century.
