Counseling Practicum and Internship - Liberty University

All students in the Counseling Programs are required to complete a three a quarter internship. This involves 600 hours on-site (200 per quarter), 240 of which are direct contact hours (80 per quarter). Students also take part in weekly group supervision class on campus each quarter. Practicum (CNS 591) and Internship (CNS 596) During the COVID-19 crisis, all interns are required to work from home. They may conduct distance counseling in accordance with the national, state, and university crisis plans once the proper training has been completed and in coordination with their site supervisors.

Students in the Professional School Counseling Program who hold two years of certified teaching experience and who reside in Texas must complete Practicum and Internship at a Texas Education Agency (TEA) approved site with a qualified Site Supervisor who holds certification in school counseling with over 3 years professional experience.

Practicum and Internship - Lamar University

Both practicum and internship involve actual on-site counseling experience. However, they differ in length and purpose. Practicum provides students with experience in individual counseling and group counseling, conducted in the context of 10 weeks of one semester and scheduled for approximately 10 to 15 hours per week.
