Based on the results of these trials, IV lidocaine at a dose of 1.5mg/kg seems to be an opioid sparing treatment option in our armamentarium to treat renal colic pain. Percutaneous Nephrolithotomy to Treat Renal Colic: Percutaneous nephrolithotomy is done under the effect of general anesthesia. A small cut is made at the back to get easy access inside the kidney for the removal of stone using light and camera attached instruments.

Treatment of nephrolithiasis involves emergency management of renal (ureteral) colic, including surgical interventions where indicated, and medical therapy for stone disease.

Nephrolithiasis Treatment & Management: Approach ...

The best and most effective treatments for the pain of renal colic are; the spontaneous passage of a urethral stone, stone removal, placement of a stent in the ureter, and percutaneous nephrostomy. Fortunately, most patients do not suffer from complete ureter obstruction and thus they do not face the risk of renal failure (9).

Therapeutic Approaches for Renal Colic in the Emergency ...

One treatment under investigation is the use of good bacteria (probiotics) to create an appropriate bacterial balance to improve overall digestive health. Some studies have shown a reduction in crying times when babies with colic were treated with a bacterium called Lactobacillus reuteri.

A Cochrane review of analgesia in renal colic was unable to determine which NSAID is best. 20 The BAUS guidelines suggest oral or parenteral diclofenac as first line treatment, 7 although choice will depend on local policies. If an opioid is used, it is recommended that pethidine is not used, owing to a high association with vomiting. 19

For over a decade, calcium channel blockers (i.e. nifedipine) and, more commonly, alpha adrenoreceptor antagonists (i.e. tamsulosin) have been employed in the treatment of ureteric colic for their potential ability to increase stone passage, reduce pain medication use and reduce urologic interventions.

Morphine 5 - 10 mg, IM, is an alternative treatment to NSAIDs for acute pain management in patients with renal colic and is preferred over NSAIDs in women who are pregnant (see: " Renal colic during pregnancy "). The concomitant administration of an antiemetic may be considered for the prevention or control of nausea and vomiting. 5

Managing patients with renal colic in primary care - BPJ ...

Patients were given one of three treatments: 50 mg IV meperidine, 60 mg IV ketorolac, or a combination of both when they had moderate to severe pain and documented renal colic.

Renal Colic Treatment - Rid yourself of the Issue Treatment is conservative or surgical, and its goal is to remove the stone or other obstacles (blood clot, pus) from the urinary tract. Conservative treatment relies on administering analgesic and spasmolytic medication and increasing fluid intake.
